
Military Group Quarters

1. WHEN will my facility be counted?



2. HOW will my facility be counted?

<u>Definition:</u> Military Group Quarters are military personnel living in barracks including open barrack transient quarters and dormitories.

Residency Criteria:

- Military Group Quarters and Military Ships are recognized separately under Census enumeration operations. Military Ships are considered "out-of-scope" for the Group Quarters Operation.
- Patients in Military Treatment Facilities are counted as part of Healthcare Group Quarters (not as a Military Group Quarter).
- People being held in military disciplinary barracks and jails are counted as part of Correctional Group Quarters (not as a Military Group Quarter).

Facility Self-Enumeration is the only enumeration method available for Military GQs.

Identify

Special instructions and unique needs of military GQs in your community and share this information with Census staff.



Coordinate

Work with Census Bureau staff to ensure receipt of the most updated list of Military GQs and their Points-of-Contact.



Invite

Census Staff to your meetings to present updates.



How You Can Help

Identify

Military Group Quarters and share this information using the GQ & TL Add Template.



Recruit

Recruit a Point-of-Contact who can oversee Facility Self-Enumeration at your Military GQ.



Inform

Those living in military GQs when/how they will be counted and explain why an accurate Census count is important.
