CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	Firefighters stopped forward progress of the fire holding the current footprint at 1,134 acres. This incident will now enter patrol status. There will be an assigned patrol to monitor the fire and ensure the established containments line hold the fire to the current footprint and ensure any potential flare ups are met with a rapid response and mitigated quickly. Forecasts show daytime highs of 92-94°F with winds 5 -10 mph out of the east southwest with gusts on the ridges reaching up to 18mph. Forecasts call for weather instability and chances of thunderstorms over the fire area in the coming days. **This is the Final Update for the Ridge Fire**
