The Disaster Case Management Program is a time-limited, scope-limited intervention that provides disaster survivors with a single point of contact to access a broad range of programs, services, and resources to address disaster-caused unmet needs.

## Disaster Case Management

- Catholic Charities (at all levels) has been involved locally and nationally since the 1960's.
- Typically provided using private donations, grants, and volunteers..

## Federal Disaster Case Management

- New commitment of federal funding to support DCM.
- Federal Disaster Declaration with Individual Assistance
- Multiple Catholic Charities agencies across the country have acted as Management and Provider Level agencies under this structure

## Mission

FEMA's DCMP supplements a State's existing disaster case management capacity through various implementation alternatives following an IA declaration. The delivery option will be based upon a comprehensive assessment, input from the State, as well as consideration of the most efficient and cost-effective delivery mechanism.
