County launches one-on-one rebuilding workshops

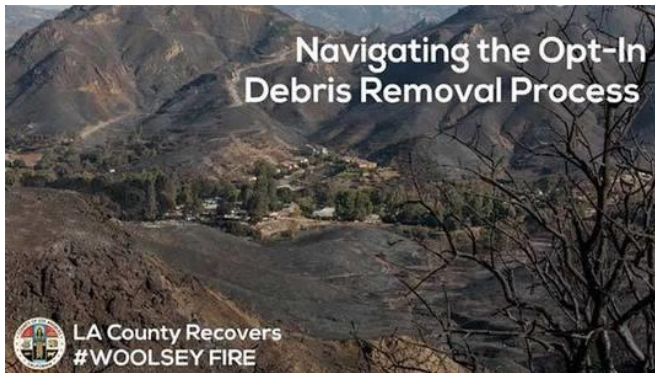
