What to Expect During Your One-On-One Rebuilding Appointment

Starting on March 2, and on alternating Saturdays through April 27, unincorporated County homeowners and businesses seeking to rebuild can schedule one-on-one appointments with County experts who are dedicated to helping the community rebuild. Each hour-long appointment will be uniquely tailored for each resident's property. During the session, residents will be given a summary sheet of the attributes and information for their property, then rotate through a series of focused conversations with the experts at Regional Planning, Fire, Public Health and Public Works. The result will be individual roadmaps to recovery, with the steps, forms and information needed to rebuild. The event also will have professionals from the Los Angeles/Ventura Chapter of the Building Industry Association of Southern California (BIA), offering help from those who work in the building industry.
